

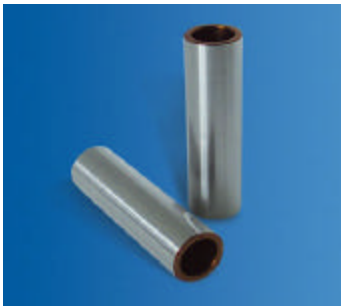


## HARDKOR NEWS

Hardkor spindle stud material boasts tensile and yield strengths double that of most stock factory examples. State-of-the-art metalworking equipment, advanced machining practices and stringent quality control guarantee our customers the quality and value they expect.

Keeping with our philosophy of continual improvement, we've redesigned our **bearing spacer** eliminating the necessity of heating prior to installation. The new configuration requires no installation tools and has the additional advantage of providing a positive seal at the spindle stud interface.



Hardkor's new **pivot bushings** for the Yamaha YFZ-450 are CNC turned from tool steel then heat treated and centerless ground to Timken Bearing specifications for internal races. This combination will provide excellent bushing life even under the most severe race conditions.
